Bookings

The completed booking form and full fee must be received in order to confirm the place. All bookings are on a first come first served basis, places will not be allocated until the full course payment has been received. Bookings are only confirmed when you have received written confirmation from Good Start Dog Training.

Fees

Fees must be paid in full at the same time as sending the booking form.

Cancellation and Refund

If you cancel a booking before the start of a course, you will be entitled to a refund as follows:

- More than one week before the start date: 75% of the course fee
- Less than one week before the start date: no refund will be made

No refunds are made if you cancel after a course has started.
